QUALIFIED DONOR STANDARD

- ▶ Part of a rigorous certification program for plasma centers.
- ▶ One of a series of safety measures reducing the risk of collecting contaminated plasma.
- ▶ Builds on the observation that repeat, committed donors are safer donors.
- ▶ Plasma from a one-time only donor cannot be used to make plasma protein therapies.
- Requires potential donors to pass two separate medical screenings and infectious disease testing, before plasma is used.

- Donors must return within six months or they lose their "Qualified Donor" status and must qualify again.
- Reduces the risk of undetected infectious units of plasma from being manufactured.
